Upon completion of the assessment, an **Assessment of Competence Certificate** will be issued in accordance with **DIA Codes** and international guidelines and procedures.

To attend the assessment of competence process, the candidate will send a documentation that includes the Curriculum Vitae, academic or vocational qualifications, letters obtained from previous professional or voluntary operational activities, etc.

In addition, the candidate is required to attend an integration training activity, essential for evaluating and updating the knowledge acquired.


